

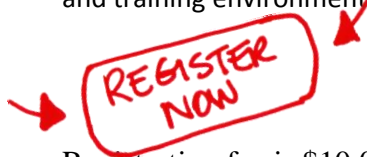
Columbus Metropolitan TOPSoccer
